Application Instructions

Rebates are available from participating Massachusetts utilities or energy efficiency service providers on the purchase and installation of a qualifying two-speed or variable-speed swimming pool pump. To be eligible, installations must include a qualifying controller as applicable. Customer may either use an existing qualifying controller or purchase and install a separate qualifying controller unit if the new variable speed or variable flow pump does not have a built-in qualifying controller. The list of qualifying swimming pool pump models and controllers can be found at masssave.com/poolpumps or by calling 1-877-378-2748.

To receive your rebate:

- 1) Customer must fill out sections 1 through 4.
- 2) Enclose a copy of your dated purchase, the model number and the installation invoice for eligible swimming pool pump/controller and a receipt.
- 3) Read Section 5.
- 4) Sign and date the Acknowledgement section.

Eligible pump must be installed within the MA electric service area of one of the participating Sponsors, be UL listed, and installed in accordance with the National Electric Code in accordance with the National Energy Code and manufacturer's recommendations. Eligible pumps include the two-speed and variable-speed models listed on masssave.com/poolpumps. For more information or to confirm eligibility, call 1-877-378-2748.

This rebate offer is available to all Massachusetts residential electric customers of participating utilities and energy efficiency service providers and may be subject to change without prior notice.
